

General notes taken from different sources

- Muhammed Hussein Tabba Tabbai's mother said that when she was pregnant, she stayed in wudhoo all the time and she never did qaza of namaz-e-shab and she used to recite Quran a lot resulting in the memorization of 20 pages of the holy Quran . When her child was born she used to play the Quran all the time. Whether the baby was asleep or awake. As a result the child's first words spoken were the words of the Quran. Both parents started to make him memorize the Quran at a very young age.
- If your child is not smart, he is not bringing good marks in class make him recite Quran and make him memorize at least 10 ayaats of Quran and you'll see the difference it makes.
- Explain your child that when a young boy or girl wakes up and recites namaaz -e-shaab, Allah is so please with him or here. The angels are amazed that being so young he remembers Allah instead of going after the worldly things, such as youngsters usually do out of ignorance, or denial
- Whenever we are in problems we always call on our 12th Imam for help. We should explain to our children that Imam Mahdi is always willing to help us not only when we are in need, but also during our day to day activities. When ever we come out of the house we should greet our present imam by saying "asalaamun alaikum yaa sahebu zamaan" and ask him to help protect you from doing any temptations whcih iblees (satan) might direct your way. We live in a country where sins make up a large portion of our day. We are attracted to it especially when we go to school and we are around our peers ect.. But if we ask our 12th Imam, he will be there for us. But our intentions have to be clean and clear.
- In west (Europe/America) where we live we need to insure everything don't we? We have to insure our car, our house so if any damage happens to them we don't get into trouble and problems. Have you thought about your imaan and your kids imaan? They need to be insured as well; for the here after. You can insure your and your children's imaan by gving it to Allah as amaanat : "Ya Allahu Ya Rahmanu Ya rahim, yaa muqalibal Qulub sabith qalbi aa'la dinik"
- A way of keeping your child's imaan safe is to give it to an imam especially the present imam and tell him that he is from now on your son please keep his imaaan safe.
- Teach your child that the best way to stay away from Gunnah is that whenever he or she is going to do or say something haram he should loudly say" (take his name) Allah is watching you" because usually we do harram things because we think nobody is watching us.

- It is not at all waajib for a women to cook, vacuum or clean the house but what is waajib for her is the tarbiyaate awlaad. She will be asked on the day of judgment of how she raised her kids because the majority of the habits are learned from the mother.
